House Wine

Crane Lake (California)

Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Merlot, and White Zinfandel \$4.50 glass / \$15 Bottle

White Wines

Arbor Crest Riesling (Washington State) \$22 or \$5 glass

Slightly sweet to balance the bright acidity and create a long and supple finish

Franz Kunzler Riesling (Rheingau, Germany) \$26

Aromas of plums and allspice. Flavors of deep peach and plum with a full generous mouthfeel

Buehler White Zinfandel (Napa Valley) \$18

Riper fruit translates to flavors like wild berries and strawberries; the end result is a wine with more red zinfandel berry character and a less sweet, more refreshing taste

Torre di Luna Pinot Grigio (Italy) \$20

Delicate aromas of pear and minerals, medium bodied w/a dry, harmonious finish

Rex Goliath Pinot Grigio (California) \$21

This wine expresses lovely aromatics of pear and honeydew. Bright, juicy flavors of citrus and apples that lead to a sweet mineral core. The finish is soft and lingering

Mad Fish Chardonnay (Australia) \$27

Young, fresh and vibrant flavors of tropical fruit w/a crisp lively finish

Big Fat Llama Chardonnay (Chile) \$18

Brilliant straw hue. Citrus, pear and dried flower aromas. This is a straightforward, non-oaked effort with moderate fruit and acidity

Estancia Pinnacles Chardonnay (California) \$23

A rich, fruity bouquet, soft and creamy texture as a result of barrel and tank fermentation

Bogle Chardonnay (California) \$19

A creamy entry gives way to reveal fresh flavors of Macintosh apple, spicy oak and a touch of cinnamon, delivers a finish long and lingering

Lava Cap Chardonnay Reserve (California) \$30

Barrel fermented w/a touch of American oak, w/a rich fruity and crisp flavor

Red Wines

Yalumba Merlot Y Series (Australia) \$21

Smooth and velvety w/a touch of spice on the aroma w/flavors of plums, blackberry and a bit of cedar on the finish

Bogle Merlot (California) \$19

Aromas of ripe cherries and cedar w/flavors of bright cherry fruit combined w/ample tannins and spicy oak and a complex finish

Bridgeview Blue Moon Merlot (Oregon) \$21

This bright, youthful, ruby colored wine evokes flavors of blueberry & black cherry

Bradgate Red Wine (South Africa) \$20

A blend of cabernet sauvignon, merlot and syrah. A very Bordeaux style blend with the twist of adding syrah. Aromas of tobacco earth and dark fruit. Flavors of cherry and vanilla with a hint of pepper

Dievole Fourplay (Italy) \$27

A dark ruby red in color, full-bodied, rich and powerful. This fruit-forward red offers aromas and flavors of blackberries, black cherries, spice and smoke

Pinocchio Nero d' Avola from (Sicily) \$18

Pretty, soft and supple red, each label has a different scene from the fable of Pinocchio!

Rex Goliath Shiraz (California) \$18

Aromas of ripe raspberries and black pepper underscored by floral perfumed notes and pretty French oak

Bogle Petite Sirah (California) \$22

A hearty wine w/rich soft tannins and plush fruit and toasty oak. Flavors of ripe plum and boysenberry fruit

Bogle Old Vines Zinfandel (California) \$23

A well balanced wine that shows bright currant and blackberry aromas w/flavors of sweet oak, spice and white pepper

Jessie's Grove - Earth Zin & Fire Old Vine Zinfandel (California) \$27

This wine has a deep opaque red-purple color and an intense nose, with forward fruit and a dense, jammy quality to the berry flavors hinted with exotic spice, soft tannins and a long smooth finish

Wild Horse Cabernet Sauvignon (California) \$39

A very Bordeaux like style of cabernet w/elements of berry, spice, black olive that evolve into a wonderful blend of aromas and rich fruit flavors

Powers Cabernet Sauvignon Mercer Ranch (Washington State) \$25

Structured flavors featuring black currant, blackberry, and spice w/overtones of toasty oak and hints of wild plums

Big Fat Llama Cabernet (Chile) \$18

Brilliant ruby red-violet hue. Black cherry, boysenberry and cigar aromas. Medium-bodied, this has ripe fruit and a finish with moderate tannins and an earthy, slightly bitter finish

Lava Cap Cabernet Sauvignon (California) \$41

Raspberry, mint, green olives, oak and vanilla make this a full-bodied wine w/a touch of cedar

Twin Islands Pinot Noir (New Zealand) \$30

This ruby colored wine shows aromas of plum and cherries with a hint of spice and pepper. It is a medium bodied wine with flavors of sweet cherry fruit and soft tannins

Yalumba - Bushvine Grenache (Australia) \$32

A deceptively complex nose of sweet, dark berry fruits, classy cinnamon oak and meaty notes. Similar characters on palate showing licorice complexity. Good fine-grained tannins and integrated oak
